Overuse of the ball in the slippery conditions & with Belconnen playing much smarter football, they managed to bridge the gap (keeping us goalless for the quarter) and ending up with a 5 point lead at halftime.

While we had better use of the football in the third quarter we were unable to convert this into scoring opportunities, kicking only 1 goal for the quarter. Thanks to some outstanding work from our Backline (with special mentions to James McIntyre and Tom Gordon) who, under extreme pressure, were able to keep Belconnen goalless for the quarter and greeted the ¾ time siren only 2 points down.

Belconnen came out flying in the fourth quarter kicking 3 goals in the first 10 minutes. With the game seemingly slipping away, it would have been very easy for the group to drop their heads and give up but credit to them, with huge efforts particularly from Brad Hancock and Ryan Kennedy (who were both fantastic all day), the team clawed their way back to be within a point with 1 minute to go. Despite winning the final centre clearance and gaining a forward entry, we ran out of time and Belconnen held on for a 1 point victory.

In the end it was another case of losing a game we should have won and the feeling in the changerooms was rightly one of extreme disappointment. However, a loss like this can be a valuable lesson and we will make sure we learn from it and become a better team for it. As stated before, credit must be given for the fightback and our ability to turn things around and score so quickly can only be a positive.
