National Risk Protection program - What is covered at a base level?

Marsh Sports insurance provides coverage for all AFL NSW/ACT AFL Clubs. The below images provide information on some of the general coverage a player may be entitled to claim for:

Note: The Tuggeranong Valley Australian Football Club (TVAFC) has silver level insurance which increases the coverage to 75% reimbursement cover for items that are not claimable in any way through Medicare, \$2500 maximum payout per claim and \$75 excess per claim.
