PATRON'S MESSAGE

Season 2023 seems to have gone by in a flash but there were many highlights for the Club both on and off the field that were underpinned by the efforts of players, coaches, managers, board members and volunteers that have again done so much for the Tuggeranong Valley Australian Football Netball Club across the senior men's and women's programs to our Rising Stars and Junior teams. The hundreds of hours that you put into pre-season, the season itself and post-season is critical to making the Club and competition tick and to the health of our great game across the territory.

No one epitomises this selfless service more than Ray Ghirardello and it was appropriate that Ray was recognised with the highest honour with his induction into the AFL Canberra Hall of Fame. Ray has put thousands of hours into volunteering for Australian Rules Football over 30 years, serving with distinction in almost every position imaginable from the playing ranks to junior and senior coaching roles, to critical board roles and a key role in bringing the Valley football clubs together as well as all the game day duties of line marking and canteen duty. There can be no better example of service to community than the extraordinary contribution that Ray has made to football in the Territory and in the Tuggeranong Valley.

And in this vein too it was great to see the Tuggeranong Valley Australian Football Netball Club receive the Prime Minister's Award as the best junior club in the ACT for 2023. Awards like this are no accident and it is testament to the hard work, enthusiasm and inclusivity of all involved in the organisation and running of the junior program. On the field there were some great results with the Rising Stars Women's team making the finals for the first time in a decade, six out of ten junior teams made the finals with the Under 16 girls winning the premiership, and the Under 11 Red Mixed and Under 14 Red Mixed teams both runner ups. There were plenty of individual achievements with representatives at national championships and several representatives in the GWS academy teams in all age groups. Of particular note were the achievements of Jesse Borghouts, League Best and Fairest Under 15 Boys, and Aiden Henderson and Isaac Owusu, equal Best and Fairest Under 14s Mixed Boys. And there were several top 10 finishes across the various age groups.

It is great to see netball going from strength to strength in the Club with significant growth, moving from six teams in the inaugural season last year to 11 teams in 2023. It was also a strong performance on the court with six teams making preliminary finals, four making grand finals and three going on to be 2023 premiers.

It has been great to have a full football season as well as continued growth in the netball program and with the strengthening of links between the Club and St Mary MacKillop College. This year it has again been great to see the recognition of game milestones for senior and junior footballers, the selection of players in GWS academy and other representative teams as well as the spotlight on the many volunteers that make this Club great. It emphasises the strength that the Club has as a community that values the efforts and input of all its members.

After a couple of years of consultation, it is timely to consider what are the next steps to take in ensuring that Australian Football in the Valley has the right investment in infrastructure to support not just the existing playing community but to support growth in football over the next decade. This is critical for the wellbeing of the code in the Territory, and I am keen to work with the Board and Club, AFL Canberra and our local and federal Governments to this end.

Thank you to everyone at the Tuggeranong Valley Australian Football Netball Club for your generosity and warm hospitality throughout 2023, where there continued to be an investment in youth in the senior programs and a recognition of the contribution made by all to the Club. It's a privilege to be involved with a Club built on character, with a respectful and inclusive culture, which makes such an incredible contribution to the community down south.
