Boundary Umpire Guidelines



The duties of a Boundary Umpire include without limitation:

- judging whether a football is Out of Bounds or Out of Bounds on the Full and signalling to the field Umpire when that has occurred
- throwing the football back into play if it has gone Out of Bounds, when directed to do so by a field Umpire
- determining whether a Player has incorrectly entered the Centre Square in contravention of Law 11.3.4 including notifying the field Umpire of Centre Square infringements
- bringing the football back to the Centre Square after a Goal has been scored
- reporting a Player or Official who commits a Reportable Offence
- Assisting goal umpires to determine a score

Important: If an on-ground incident has occurred, an unregistered Boundary Umpire is not permitted to approach any of the players or report a player. If the Boundary Umpire is approached by the registered field umpire, they can inform the field umpire of what has occurred.
